You must attach a copy of your Arizona Driver's license, or Arizona Identification Card. The address on the license or ID must match the address on the application.

Attach a copy of the front page of your previous year's tax returns (You may block out Social Security numbers). If you do not file taxes, then you must attach a copy of your Social Security, Supplemental Security Income, or Social Security Disability year end statement. If you receive a pension or unemployment benefits, then attach proof. Your documents will be safely stored until the process is complete and then they will be destroyed.

Failure to include any of the required documentation will result in rejection of the application.

Falsification or omission of any information on the application or supporting documents will be grounds for rejection and or repayment of funding.

The SPOT program will **not** be responsible for any vaccinations or blood work that is required prior to spaying/neutering. If there are any special charges for your pet being in heat, pregnant or obese those charges are the responsibility of the owner.

Approved applicants will be notified. Upon approval you will make your own appointment with the vet and provide your own transportation.
